## Self-Adhesive Poster Paper

**ImagePerfect™ 2410 is a highly scratchproof, self-adhesive paper that is intended for indoor applications. It meets the requirements of ISO 14001 and has been specially created for digital printing on large-format inkjet printers and is suitable for printing with eco solvent and solvent inks as well as UV-cured and latex inks.**

ImagePerfect™ 2410 is a self-adhesive, extremely scratchproof paper that offers excellent opacity due to its blueback nature. It is intended for indoor applications on flat, smooth panels in environments such as trade shows, show rooms, theatres and offices. Images printed on the surface are highly scratchproof even when wet. This paper has a top-coat which results in exceptionally high print quality and output can be printed very economically. Heavy ink loads would result in much longer drying times, which could cause problems when printing roll to roll. This paper meets the requirements of ISO 14001 and it can be validated, therefore, as being sustainable, environmentally-friendly and ecologically produced, with the production of the wood that is used in the production of the paper being a socially and environmentally responsible process.

Printing recommendations: Be aware that paper is sensitive to heat and humidity and it will tend, therefore, to show buckling much faster than some other types of media. Buckling may occur when the material is left to sit on the heater plate without printing. In such cases, before printing is resumed, please perform a media feed in order to move the potential buckles away from the danger zone, thereby avoiding printhead strikes.
