4. Special note

The materials were not tested after an outside storage.

In combination with other materials (for example coatings, deposits) the burning behaviour could be influenced unfavourable so that the classification above is not valid any longer. According to DIN 4102-1 the burning behaviour in combination with other materials has to be tested separately.
