

## REACH – Effects of the EU and U.K. chemical regulation on ImagePerfect products

## Dear Customer,

In accordance with article 33 of the EU REACH Regulation, any supplier of an article containing a substance on the list in a concentration above 0.1% (w/w) shall provide the recipient with sufficient information to allow safe use of the article including, as a minimum, the name of that substance.

On the 14h June 2023, the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) extended the candidate list, <u>SVHC</u>, so it now includes 235 substances of very high concern.

Following a subsequent review within our suppliers, we are pleased to confirm that all product branded as ImagePerfect<sup>™</sup> continue to be fully compliant with the REACH Regulations (EC) No. 1907/2006. The articles or mixtures we supply do not contain components in quantities of 0.1% (w/W) or more considered to have endocrine disrupting properties according to the Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2017/2100 or Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2018/605.

This product information is based on our current knowledge, supplier confirmations and experience. It cannot be excluded that minute traces of foreign substances could be introduced through technologically unavoidable contaminations of individual raw material components. We do not routinely analyse our products for the presence of such substances. We cannot accept any warranty or liability for factors beyond our knowledge and control.

## Eikon Ltd, ImagePerfect<sup>™</sup> and the EU REACH regulation

The REACH Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 went into force on June 1, 2007. What does REACH mean? The abbreviation REACH stands for Registration, Evaluation and Authorization of Chemicals. Manufacturers and importers of chemicals in quantities of 1 ton or more per year (per substance) are required to have them registered with the new Helsinki-based European Chemicals Agency (ECHA). For this purpose, a dossier must be submitted, providing information on the hazardous level of the substance, together with its applications and measures to allow for safe use. That means that all our manufacturers within the EC, or importers into the EC, are required to have their chemical substances registered if they are falling under this qualification. Our team is committed to fully comply with all pertinent regulations to the best of our knowledge and belief.

## Eikon Ltd, ImagePerfect<sup>™</sup> and the UK REACH regulation

After the withdrawal of the United Kingdom UK REACH has been activated, which is similar to the EU REACH regulation, the candidate list for the U.K. can be found at this link, <u>SVCH</u>. Following a subsequent review within our suppliers, we are pleased to confirm that all product branded as **ImagePerfect<sup>TM</sup>** are fully compliant with the UK Article 57(f). The articles or mixtures we supply do not contain components in quantities of 0.1% (w/W) or more considered to have endocrine disrupting properties according to UK REACH Article 57(f).
